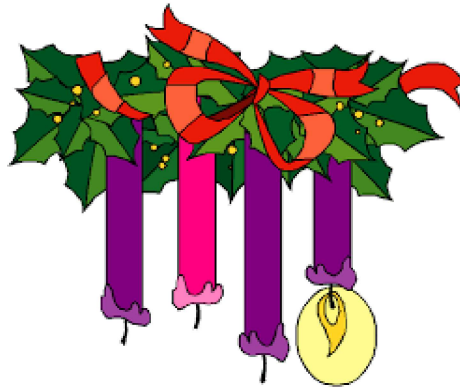


'BELIEVING OURSELVES TO BE PART OF NATURE CHANGES HOW WE BEHAVE' Earth Law Centre.

'The poor and the needy will be treated with fairness and justice... Calves and lions will eat together and be cared for by little children.' Is.11:4, 6.

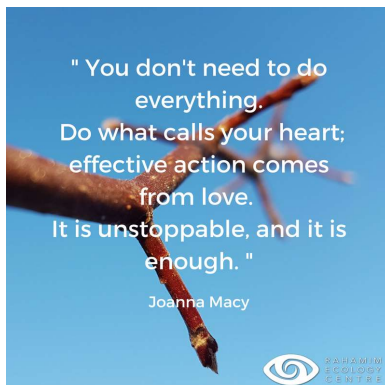
Isaiah, the Advent prophet speaks of this Creation-Human harmony:

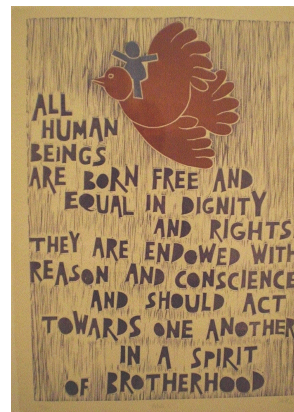


REAL CHANGE - Comes from taking
