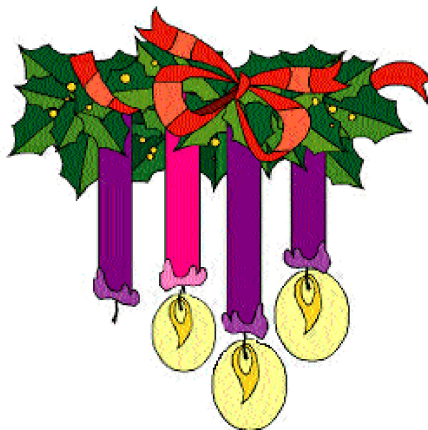

BIODIVERSITY - OUR LIFE SUPPORT SYSTEM

What is Biodiversity?

BIODIVERSITY is the variety of all life forms on Earth, The more plant, insect and animal species there are in one area the greater the biodiversity and the healthier the ecosystem!

An **ECOSYSTEM** is a community made up of living organisms and non-living components such as air, water, minerals and soil. In an ecosystem, each organism has its role and purpose.



Why is it important?

Biodiversity underpins the functioning of the ecosystems on which we depend for survival, CLEAN AIR, FRESHWATER, FOOD, HEALTH, RECREATION AND PROTECTION FROM NATURAL DISASTERS.

Our food production depends heavily upon pollinators such as bees .

All over the world bee populations are threatened - in Ireland **one third** of bee species face **extinction**.



Loss of Biodiversity

The wildlife population has decreased by 60% in just over 40 years.

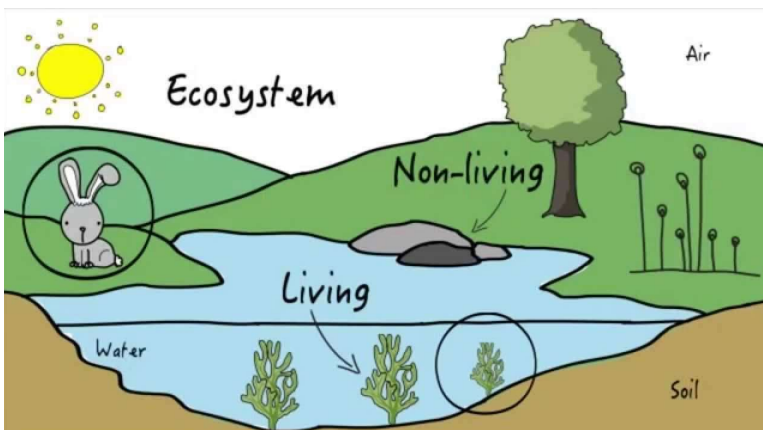
Living Planet Index 2018
